

PROPHECIES OF THE MESSIAH FULFILLED

Gen 3:15 And I will put enmity between thee and the woman, and between thy seed and her seed; it shall bruise thy head, and thou shalt bruise his heel.

The first promise of the Messiah occurs here in Genesis.....

However, many claim that Satan's head was bruised at the cross but this cannot be so....

Rom 16:20 And the ***God of peace shall bruise Satan under your feet shortly***. The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ *be* with you. Amen.

This means that Satan's head hasn't been bruised yet...But it will be....

1Co 15:54 So when this corruptible shall have put on incorruption, and this mortal shall have put on immortality, then shall be brought to pass the saying that is written, Death is swallowed up in victory.

1Co 15:55 O death, where is thy sting? O grave, where is thy victory?

Death was defeated at the cross.....

Let's examine a few of the fulfilled and yet to be fulfilled Prophecies concerning the Messiah....

1. Prophecy that salvation would come thru the Jewish nation.

Gen 12:3 And I will bless them that bless thee, and curse him that curseth thee: and in thee shall all families of the earth be blessed.

Joh 4:22 Ye worship ye know not what: we know what we worship: for salvation is of the Jews.

2. Prophecy that Christ will come from the tribe of Judah.

Gen 49:9 Judah is a lion's whelp: from the prey, my son, thou art gone up: he stooped down, he couched as a lion, and as an old lion; who shall rouse him up?

Gen 49:10 The sceptre shall not depart from Judah, nor a lawgiver from between his feet, until Shiloh come; and unto him *shall* the gathering of the people *be*.

Rev 5:5 And one of the elders saith unto me, Weep not: behold, the Lion of the tribe of Juda, the Root of David, hath prevailed to open the book, and to loose the seven seals thereof.

3. Prophecy that Jesus would be a Jew and a prophet. God would command the people to hear Him. Jesus would also be like God.

Deu 18:15 The LORD thy God will raise up unto **thee a Prophet** from the midst of thee, **of thy brethren, like unto me; unto him ye shall hearken;**

Mat 17:5 While he yet spake, behold, a bright cloud overshadowed them: and behold a voice out of the cloud, which said, This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased; hear ye him.

Mat 14:5 And when he would have put him to death, he feared the multitude, because they counted him as a prophet.

Joh 4:9 Then saith the woman of Samaria unto him, How is it that thou, being a Jew, askest drink of me, which am a woman of Samaria? for the Jews have no dealings with the Samaritans.

Joh 14:9 Jesus saith unto him, Have I been so long time with you, and yet hast thou not known me, Philip? he that hath seen me hath seen the Father; and how sayest thou *then*, Shew us the Father?

4. Prophecy that the people would take counsel against Him and state that they want nothing to do with Him..

Psa 2:2 The kings of the earth set themselves, and the rulers take counsel together, against the LORD, and against his anointed, *saying*,

Psa 2:3 Let us break their bands asunder, and cast away their cords from us.

Mat 22:15 Then went the Pharisees, and took counsel how they might entangle him in *his* talk.

Joh 11:53 Then from that day forth they took counsel together for to put him to death.

Joh 19:15 But they cried out, Away with *him*, away with *him*, crucify him. Pilate saith unto them, Shall I crucify your King? The chief priests answered, We have no king but Caesar.

5. Prophecy He would be given vinegar and gall to drink.

Psa 69:21 They gave me also gall for my meat; and in my thirst they gave me vinegar to drink.

Mat 27:34 They gave him vinegar to drink mingled with gall: and when he had tasted *thereof*, he would not drink.

6. Prophecy He would be born of a virgin.

Isa 7:14 Therefore the Lord himself shall give you a sign; Behold, a virgin shall conceive, and bear a son, and shall call his name Immanuel.

Mat 1:20 But while he thought on these things, behold, the angel of the Lord appeared unto him in a dream, saying, Joseph, thou son of David, fear not to take unto thee Mary thy wife: for that which is conceived in her is of the Holy Ghost.

Mat 1:21 And she shall bring forth a son, and thou shalt call his name JESUS: for he shall save his people from their sins.

Mat 1:22 Now all this was done, that it might be fulfilled which was spoken of the Lord by the prophet, saying,

Mat 1:23 Behold, a virgin shall be with child, and shall bring forth a son, and they shall call his name Emmanuel, which being interpreted is, God with us.

Mat 1:24 Then Joseph being raised from sleep did as the angel of the Lord had bidden him, and took unto him his wife:

Mat 1:25 And knew her not till she had brought forth her firstborn son: and he called his name JESUS.

WHY DID JESUS HAVE TO BE BORN OF A VIRGIN?

Jer 22:30 Thus saith the LORD, Write ye this man childless, a man *that* shall not prosper in his days: for no man of his seed shall prosper, sitting upon the throne of David, and ruling any more in Judah.

Jer 36:30 Therefore thus saith the LORD of Jehoiakim king of Judah; He shall have none to sit upon the throne of David: and his dead body shall be cast out in the day to the heat, and in the night to the frost.

Because God had decreed that Jehoiakim (of Judah) would never have anyone from his lineage sit on the throne.

7. Prophecy that Jesus would be the light.

Isa 9:2 The people that walked in darkness have seen a great light: they that dwell in the land of the shadow of death, upon them hath the light shined.

Joh 12:46 I am come a light into the world, that whosoever believeth on me should not abide in darkness.

8. Prophecy that God would come in the flesh.

Isa 9:6 For unto us a child is born, unto us a son is given: and the government shall be upon his shoulder: and his name shall be called Wonderful, Counsellor, **The mighty God**, The everlasting Father, The Prince of Peace.

Isa 9:7 Of the increase of *his* government and peace *there shall be* no end, upon the throne of David, and upon his kingdom, to order it, and to establish it with judgment and with justice from henceforth even for ever. The zeal of the LORD of hosts will perform this.

1Ti 3:16 And without controversy great is the mystery of godliness: God was manifest in the flesh, justified in the Spirit, seen of angels, preached unto the Gentiles, believed on in the world, received up into glory.

9. Prophecy that Jesus would be a Nazarene.

Isa 11:1 And there shall come forth a rod out of the stem of Jesse, and a **Branch** shall grow out of his roots:

Mat 2:23 And he came and dwelt in a city called Nazareth: that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by the prophets, He shall be called a Nazarene.

Notice Branch is capitalized in the King James Bible showing a proper name. Branch "netzer" is the definition of Nazareth means "Branch".

10. Prophecy that the Spirit would descend on Jesus.

Isa 42:1 Behold my servant, whom I uphold; mine elect, *in whom* my soul delighteth; I have put my spirit upon him: he shall bring forth judgment to the Gentiles.

Mat 3:16 And Jesus, when he was baptized, went up straightway out of the water: and, lo, the heavens were opened unto him, and he saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove, and lighting upon him:

11. Prophecy that Jesus would be beaten beyond recognition and His blood would save the world.

Isa 52:14 As many were astonished at thee; **his visage was so marred more than any man, and his form more than the sons of men:**

Isa 52:15 **So shall he sprinkle many nations;** the kings shall shut their mouths at him: for *that* which had not been told them shall they see; and *that* which they had not heard shall they consider.

Mat 27:26 Then released he Barabbas unto them: **and when he had scourged Jesus,** he delivered *him* to be crucified.

Mat 26:67 Then did **they spit in his face, and buffeted him; and others smote *him* with the palms of their hands,**

Heb 9:19 For when Moses had spoken every precept to all the people according to the law, he took the blood of calves and of goats, with water, and scarlet wool, and hyssop, and sprinkled both the book, and all the people,

Heb 9:20 Saying, This is the blood of the testament which God hath enjoined unto you.

Heb 9:21 Moreover he sprinkled with blood both the tabernacle, and all the vessels of the ministry.

Heb 9:22 And almost all things are by the law purged with blood; and without shedding of blood is no remission.

Heb 9:23 *It was* therefore necessary that the patterns of things in the heavens should be purified with these; but the heavenly things themselves with better sacrifices than these.

Heb 9:24 For Christ is not entered into the holy places made with hands, *which are* the figures of the true; but into heaven itself, now to appear in the presence of God for us:

Heb 9:25 Nor yet that he should offer himself often, as the high priest entereth into the holy place every year with blood of others;

Heb 9:26 For then must he often have suffered since the foundation of the world: but now once in the end of the world hath he appeared to put away sin by the sacrifice of himself.

PROPHECY OF 2nd ADVENT

***If the 1st birth that was predicted came to pass, then rest assure that the 2nd coming of Jesus will transpire as well.**

12. First & Second advent in prophecy

Isa 61:1 The Spirit of the Lord GOD is upon me; because the LORD hath anointed me to preach good tidings unto the meek; he hath sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to *them that are* bound;

Isa 61:2 To proclaim the acceptable year of the LORD, and the day of vengeance of our God; to comfort all that mourn;

NOTICE THE COMMA BETWEEN "LORD" and "the day of vengeance" in verse 2. This notates the 1st & 2nd ad

Rev 6:16 And said to the mountains and rocks, Fall on us, and hide us from the face of him that sitteth on the throne, and from the wrath of the Lamb:

Rev 6:17 For the great day of his wrath is come; and who shall be able to stand?

13. Prophecy of Jesus returning with rewards at 2nd advent.

Isa 62:11 Behold, the LORD hath proclaimed unto the end of the world, Say ye to the daughter of Zion, Behold, thy salvation cometh; behold, his reward is with him, and his work before him.

Rev 22:12 And, behold, I come quickly; and my reward is with me, to give every man according as his work shall be.

13. Prophecy of Jesus' garments being stained with blood (Armageddon).

Isa 63:1 Who is this that cometh from Edom, with dyed garments from Bozrah? this *that is* glorious in his apparel, travelling in the greatness of his strength? I that speak in righteousness, mighty to save.

Isa 63:2 Wherefore *art thou* red in thine apparel, and thy garments like him that treadeth in the winefat?

Isa 63:3 I have trodden the winepress alone; and of the people *there was* none with me: for I will tread them in mine anger, and trample them in my fury; and their blood shall be sprinkled upon my garments, and I will stain all my raiment.

Isa 63:4 For the day of vengeance is in mine heart, and the year of my redeemed is come.

Rev 14:20 And the winepress was trodden without the city, and blood came out of the winepress, even unto the horse bridles, by the space of a thousand *and* six hundred furlongs.

14. Prophecy of His millennial reign (1,000- year reign of Christ on earth)

Dan 2:44 And in the days of these kings shall the God of heaven set up a kingdom, which shall never be destroyed: and the kingdom shall not be left to other people, *but* it shall break in pieces and consume all these kingdoms, and it shall stand for ever.

Rev 20:1 And I saw an angel come down from heaven, having the key of the bottomless pit and a great chain in his hand.

Rev 20:2 And he laid hold on the dragon, that old serpent, which is the Devil, and Satan, and bound him a thousand years,

Rev 20:3 And cast him into the bottomless pit, and shut him up, and set a seal upon him, that he should deceive the nations no more, till the thousand years should be fulfilled: and after that he must be loosed a little season.

Rev 20:4 And I saw thrones, and they sat upon them, and judgment was given unto them: and *I saw* the souls of them that were beheaded for the witness of Jesus, and for the word of God, and which had not worshipped the beast, neither his image, neither had received *his* mark upon their foreheads, or in their hands; and they lived and reigned with Christ a thousand years.

Rev 20:5 But the rest of the dead lived not again until the thousand years were finished. This *is* the first resurrection.

Rev 20:6 Blessed and holy *is* he that hath part in the first resurrection: on such the second death hath no power, but they shall be priests of God and of Christ, and shall reign with him a thousand years.

15. Prophecy Jesus would be called out of Egypt.

Hos 11:1 When Israel *was* a child, then I loved him, and called my son out of Egypt.

Mat 2:14 When he arose, he took the young child and his mother by night, and departed into Egypt:

16. How Jesus would die was described (Crucifixion)

Zec 12:10 And I will pour upon the house of David, and upon the inhabitants of Jerusalem, the spirit of grace and of supplications: and **they shall look upon me whom they have pierced**, and they shall mourn for him, as one mourneth for *his* only son, and shall be in bitterness for him, as one that is in bitterness for *his* firstborn.

Zec 13:6 And *one* shall say unto him, What *are* these wounds in thine hands? Then he shall answer, *Those* with which I was wounded *in* the house of my friends.

Mar 15:24 And when they had crucified him, they parted his garments, casting lots upon them, what every man should take.

17. Jesus would be betrayed for 30 pieces of silver.

Zec 11:12 And I said unto them, If ye think good, give *me* my price; and if not, forbear. **So they weighed for my price thirty pieces of silver.**

Zec 11:13 And the LORD said unto me, Cast it unto the potter: a goodly price that I was prised at of them. And I took the thirty *pieces* of silver, **and cast them to the potter in the house of the LORD.**

Mat 27:3 Then Judas, which had betrayed him, when he saw that he was condemned, repented himself, and brought again the thirty pieces of silver to the chief priests and elders,

Mat 27:4 Saying, I have sinned in that I have betrayed the innocent blood. And they said, What *is that* to us? see thou *to that*.

Mat 27:5 And he cast down the pieces of silver in the temple, and departed, and went and hanged himself.

Mat 27:6 And the chief priests took the silver pieces, and said, It is not lawful for to put them into the treasury, because it is the price of blood.

Mat 27:7 And they took counsel, and bought with them the potter's field, to bury strangers in.

Mat 27:8 Wherefore that field was called, The field of blood, unto this day.

18. Would cast lots at the crucifixion.

Psa 22:18 They part my garments among them, and cast lots upon my vesture.

Mat 27:35 And they crucified him, and parted his garments, casting lots: that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by the prophet, They parted my garments among them, and upon my vesture did they cast lots.

Daniel 9:25-27---Prophecied the exact time of the birth Christ

Zechariah 9:9 with Matt. 21:2-7---Prophecy of Jesus entering Jerusalem

Micah 5:2 with Matt. 2:1--Prophecy of Jesus being born in Bethlehem

Daniel 7:13 with Matthew 26:64--Jesus will come back in the clouds

Jeremiah 23:5 with 2 Tim 4:1 & John 5:22--Jesus will judge.

Isaiah 53:2-12 with John 15:5, Luke 4:21-23 & Matthew 8:8-17--Prophecy of Jesus being the vine, not being an attract that he would heal the sick....

Malachi 4:2 with Mark 5:25-27--That Messiah would have healing in His wings...

Psalms 45:2 with Luke 4:22--Grace would be poured into His lips

Psalms 118:22 with 1 Peter 2: 8 & Matthew 16:8--Jesus would be the Rock.

Isaiah 11:10 with Matt 12:21, Luke 20:30-32, Rom. 1:16--Jesus would turn to the Gentiles
